A Prospering Textiles Market

Morocco is in eighth place among the leading exporters of textile products to Europe, according to data published by the Euro-Med terranean Circle of Textile Clothing Leaders (CEDITH).

According to this organization, the textile market has experienced notable growth compared to previous years. CEDITH states that textile exports to Europe increased by 31% during the first quarter of 2022.

The Moroccan textile union has ambitious plans to expand that: By 2025, it wants to have Morocco positioned as the most significant player in the textile industry across the African continent and the second one by the Mediterranean.

The textile and clothing industry is a strategically important sector for the Moroccan economy. According to the Moroccan Ministry of Industry, Commerce, and the Digital Economy, it accounts for 7% of all industrial added value and 5% of all industrial production .

The garment production capacity in Morocco is estimated at 1 billion pieces annually, while the export turnover is estimated at \$ 3.6 billion, accounting for 12% of total exports.

The sector includes 1,600+ companies employing 190,000 people, accounting for 27% of all industrial employment. Aside from fast fashion, Moroccan production includes knitwear, denim, and textiles for the Moroccan automotive and aeronautical industries.





Investments in textiles industries by segment in Morocco are as classified as follows:

Fast Fashion 52% | Technical Textiles 17% | Denim 11% | Mesh 11% | Home Textiles 7% | Distributors for National Brands 1%

The Moroccan government has so far supported 102 investment projects in the textile sector worth 3.07 billion dirhams. With the launch of these textile projects, the government aims to revive the industry and create more than 15,555 stable jobs.

This will allow the country to generate "an expected turnover of more than MAD 6.96 billion for the third consecutive year, 44% of which is destined for the local market".

Moroccan textile operators aim to regain 40 percent of the market share at the national level, achieve a turnover of 60 billion dirhams in exports, and reach 60 percent of production in sourcing and finished products.

Morocco imports 85% of the raw materials required for the industry, according to the International Finance Corporation's most recent report.

The textile industry must also adhere to European sustainability and recycling requirements to increase Morocco's market share in the European and American markets, which bought Moroccan textiles worth \$46 million in 2021.

Morocco aims to develop a more ecological, sustainable textile sector that can satisfy the demands of customers becoming more concerned with environmental issues.
